Poster presentations guidelines

Poster Session 1: Friday 13.45 - 14.45

Poster Session 2: Saturday 13.45 - 14.45

Board dimensions: 4 feet x 5 feet (height/width = landscape format).

- Presenters must set up right after registration / arrival in the morning on the day of their presentation.
- Presenters will have an assigned board at the conference.
- You may leave your presentation up after the poster session, but please take everything with you when you leave for the day.
- Each presenter is provided with one poster board + push pins. Do not write or paint directly on the display boards. AV equipment and electricity are not provided.
- The poster sessions coincide with the lunch break on both days. Lunch is served as a buffet, so we encourage presenters to get their lunch quickly and bring it to their poster display.

Poster sessions in general:

- A poster session is a presentation where materials such as maps, photographs, graphs, charts, and/or tables are posted on a display board along with brief textual summaries of the presenter's work.
- Each poster display should include a sign with title(s) and name(s) of the presenter(s) in large, easy-to-read letters.
- A well-constructed poster is self-explanatory, and a successful poster presentation achieves both coverage and clarity. Extensive, imaginative use of captioned illustrations, photos, graphs, or other types of visually appealing material is an extremely effective mode of communication in a poster presentation. Remember to label each section of your presentation clearly.
- People attending poster sessions are free to move about from poster to poster, and there is not enough time for people to read excessive text. Text should be limited to four or five pages of double-spaced, 16-20 point text. This allows lettering to be read from several feet away.
